1. Opening Business. The agenda was adopted. 1st Matt Weinrich 2nd Jean Murphy Atkins. Minutes Adopted 1st Jean Murphy Atkins. 2nd Erin Johnson. Spring sports schedules were exchanged.
2. Public Input. None.
3. Board of Managers Report. Division 5 Basketball- 5 teams move on. The rest are still 2. Track is looking at JV's being able to come up and run with Varsity in Section finals because of Senior Activities. From Liz: Football proposal for Feb. 15 Board of managers meeting will be voted on in this order: Date. (Div. 1 & 2 would like to play the Saturday after Thanksgiving) the rest remain status quo. Central Venue-Either Oroville or Redding. And Realignment of divisions-stay status quo or make divisions by CBEDS number. Recommendation-SVL Vote no on all three by league vote. Want to make equitable awards for all sports. Looking at an exception for league games where JV's can play on the Varsity against teams that do not field JV teams and then can move back down-just watch for total contacts vs. everyone. Uprep is in the NAL for Soccer. North would like a division championship for fall soccer (not in season of sport). League votes to support this. Wrestling will change as to how to select officials to bypass guaranteed spots. Alternates for state will have to weigh in and schools will have to pay for them. Chester would like to contract with other officials than Chico and would drive up SVL mileage costs-SVL position is no. Winters wants to move to American conference and Hayfork to California conference- SVL yes. Track changes coming in pole vault. Coaches must be trained. Golf looking at changes. Tennis bracketing will change. Mostly for upper divisions. Recommendations-Transfer rule 207 may change. Valid move 206 may change. Wells Fargo is offering an insurance program for concussion injuries where schools can pay \$5 per athlete per team. Concussion forms for the north section are available online for most schools athletic packets- schools should use them.
4. All league meeting discussion. Gary 1st, Matt 2nd. Create form for all league meetings where coaches email to president or secretary or league rep with picks and choices for MVP where all teams have input. No more area meetings.
5. Soccer Make sure coaches post on maxpreps. There are 2 different leagues. Will look at soccer schedule and create based on teams that are planning to hold soccer next

- year. Make sure basketball is posted on Maxpreps. Soccer and basketball must opt out to avoid playoffs and penalties.
6. Track and Field. League meet is at Yuba College on Wednesday-coaches meeting at 11:00AM. Mt. Shasta will host the division 3 meet at 12:00 the following Friday, May 18. Greg to Order medals for league meet. Make sure everything is posted on Athletic.net including before league meet so entries can be dragged over.
 7. Basketball Durham would like to separate boys and girls playing on Tuesday nights with boys playing Wednesdays. All play Friday-Vote tabled until next meeting.
 8. Wrestling. To be held in Durham this weekend on Saturday at 10:00AM
 9. Football-League reports same as #3 above. SVL will vote no on all proposals. A look will be made at all playoff reports involving points. Point system could be recommended for change.
 10. Baseball-Playoffs will remain the same-status quo.
 11. LeMaster scholarship-Due to section office by May 1. Must get to Gary or Matt by April 23 so it can be reviewed and recommendations can be forwarded. Recommend 1 boy and 1 girl.
 12. Other-Playoff Reps - Buljit Dhami will be replaced by Steve Pisenti next year. Softball-Randy Watt will be replaced next year due to retirement. Either Hamilton or Live Oak will replace-to be determined next meeting. Next Meeting is April 26 at 10:00 in Willows.
